Showcasing the Future of Security Technology

From next-generation weapon systems to AI-powered forensic tools, the expo served as a launchpad for several transformative technologies:

SSS Defence – Empowering Atmanirbhar Bharat, India's premier OEM for small and medium caliber weapons, SSS Defence presented its latest advanced ammunition and hard-kill Counter-UAS systems, proudly designed and manufactured in India.

MSAB – Global Mobile Forensics Leader, Since 2003, MSAB has enabled smarter and faster investigations through advanced mobile data extraction and digital evidence management tools, trusted by law enforcement agencies worldwide.

PaladinAi – The Brain Behind Digital Policing, with platforms like DeepGaze, Intelliview, and Phonetic AI, PaladinAi offered revolutionary solutions for deepfake detection, big data analytics, and real-time audio-video forensics, aiding investigations at every stage.

Deepfake Detection Technology, A UK-based Company showcased advanced AI-driven technology capable of analysing various digital formats to detect AI-generated forgeries. The technology can detect synthetic voice clone besides audio & video manipulation or tampered image.

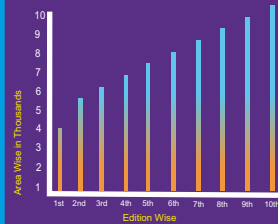

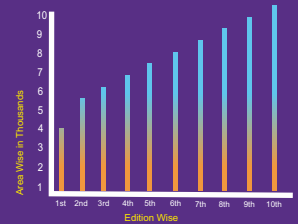

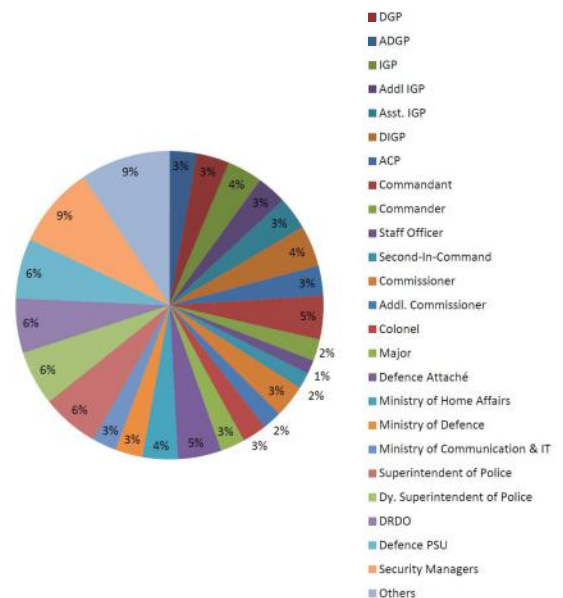
Area Growth Edition Wise
