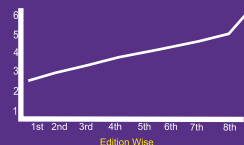

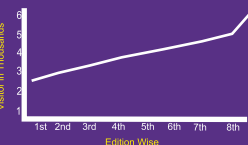

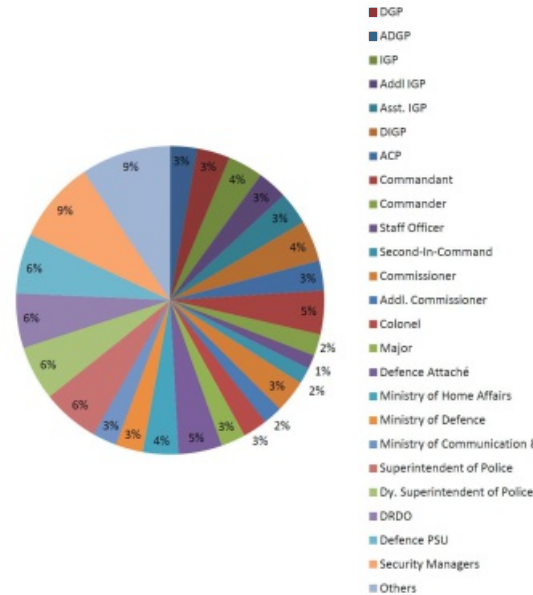
Area Growth Edition Wise

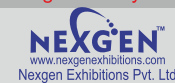
